When it comes to skin, breakouts are hands down the number one issue among teens. It not only affects their skin, it lowers their self-confidence and their self-esteem. In fact, when we researched teen skin issues, we found that teenagers valued clear skin more than "enjoying life and having fun."

That's why we created Clear Start™, a serious skin care line dedicated to clearing up breakout-prone teen skin.

What causes breakouts among teens?

Acne is generally part-genetic, part-hormonal. But unlike adult acne, which tends to be inflammatory and related to stress, teenage acne is usually triggered by puberty.

As teenagers transition from children to adults, puberty triggers the movement of new chemicals in the body. Androgen hormones, often called "male" hormones even though they are present in both males and females, become more pronounced at this time. These often play a significant role in teen breakouts.

Androgen hormones stimulate hair growth and sebaceous (oil) gland activity, which increases oil production. That excess oil can mix with skin cells and clump together, forming a plug that gets infected with Propionibacterium acnes (P. acnes) bacteria, swells and becomes a breakout. Pores (follicles) can also become larger, skin can appear shinier and rougher, cheeks may feel more sensitive or look pink, and of course,

blackheads, whiteheads and inflamed lesions can appear on the face, neck, chest, back and shoulders.

Blackheads are open, non-inflammatory comedones that form when a sebaceous follicle becomes impacted with residual oil, bacteria and materials such as hair, dead skin cells and make-up. (The black color in a blackhead is not dirt but trapped excess oils that have changed color after coming in contact with oxygen.) These are usually not severe and can be removed via extraction.

Whiteheads are non-inflammatory comedones that occur just like blackheads, but the pore is closed instead of open. These usually go away on their own but can grow into more severe forms of acne if they become irritated.

Inflamed lesions can form when the follicle wall ruptures. This results in red or swollen papules. If the break in the follicle is close to the surface, it can become a pustule, a circumscribed elevation of the skin that contains pus. If the break occurs deeper beneath the surface, it can become a nodule, which is larger and harder than a pustule. When a membrane traps the infection, it can turn into a cyst, which can cause scarring.

Many teens and young adults, especially boys, also suffer from back acne, (often called "backne" or "bacne"). Abrasive athletic clothing items such as football shoulder pads are often the culprit, as they can trap sweat and dead skin cells. A general over-secretion of the oil glands on the back can also lead to breakouts.

How do you treat, clear and prevent breakouts among teens?

Treating breakouts among teenagers can be more difficult than treating breakouts among adults. This is because most teenagers' bodies are not fully formed, let alone their skin care habits. Yet, according to our research, most teens today spend more time on their skin than baby boomers! Getting teens to establish an effective regimen at this stage can set them up for a lifetime of clear, healthy skin. Their key focus at this stage should be to unclog pores, minimize breakoutcausing bacteria and control oil.

Thorough cleansing, toning and moisturizing day and night is a good start, as well as incorporating extra clearing products that work to reduce impaction plugs, kill bacteria, control excess sebum and reduce Inflammation.


Using comedogenic (pore-clogging) ingredients and cleansing with very hot water should be avoided as they can exacerbate breakouts. Also, instead of mentholated or alcohol-based toners, which can strip skin of oil it needs and trigger even more oil production, teens should use gentle exfoliants. These can help rid oily skin of dulling and pore-blocking skin cells, and enhance skin's receptiveness of oil-controlling ingredients.

Increasing water intake can also help keep skin clear as well as flush out toxins, carry nutrients through the body and improve blood circulation. Hydrated skin is less prone to breakouts and tends to be neither too oily nor too dry.

Sensitive skin can be kept in check with soothing, cooling ingredients as well as soap-free cleansers. Teens with sensitive skin should avoid fabric softener sheets, which are made of animal fat (namely beef lard), not to mention artificial fragrance. This comedogenic coating can get on pillowcases, irritate skin and clog pores.

Backne can be treated the same way breakouts are treated on the face. Contrary to popular practice, overcleansing the skin with harsh soap, vigorous scrubbing movements, or rough loofahs and back brushes isn't necessary or effective. It will only make backne worse.



The Face Mapping® skin analysis procedure provides the skin therapist an objective view of the skin's condition, as well as an indication of the underlying health issues that might be affecting it. Rather than analyzing the skin in general terms, Face Mapping® skin analysis divides the face into 14 distinct zones, each with its own set of potential problems and unique needs. Using the zones and the Dermalogica Face Mapping® skin analysis outline as a guide, the therapist is able to conduct an inch-by-inch, methodical analysis of the facial landscape, guaranteeing that the subsequent professional treatment and home care prescription will fully address each client's concerns.



working with the Clear Start™ face mapping® skin analysis prescription sheet

As soon as your client arrives, request that he/she fully completes the Dermalogica Consultation Card. For a returning client, request that he/she reviews the information that you have on file, and re-signs the form.

Take the opportunity to review your client's Consultation Card while he/ she is changing, taking care to look for any issues that might contraindicate a phase of the treatment. Also, review any prior Clear Start™ Face Mapping® skin analysis Prescription Sheets, or start a new one by filling out the upper left side of the form.

Take the client to the treatment on bed and cleanse eyes and lips with Soothing Eye Make-Up Remover or PreCleanse on damp cotton.

4 Perform the Dermalogica Double Cleanse routine that begins with PreCleanse* and follows with the prescribed Clear Start™ Cleanser. Do not place eye pads over the client's eye area, as you will need to feel around this zone during the Clear Start™ Face Mapping® skin analysis.

5 Explain that there are 14 zones to the face, neck and chest, and that you will proceed to analyze each one inch-by-inch using the thumbs and fingers to feel for any problems. You may want to incorporate a magnifying lamp or magnifying headset for a closer view, but keep in mind that Face Mapping® skin analysis is based more on tactile than visual cues for increased accuracy. (This portion of the treatment should last around 10 minutes on the first visit, and about 5 minutes on subsequent visits.)

Begin the Face Mapping® skin analysis procedure at Zone 1. Look for the possible symptoms outlined in the "Face Mapping® skin analysis zone-byzone" outline (see following pages) by moving your thumb and index finger over the skin.

Keeping physical contact with Zone 1, so your client knows what area you're talking about, begin to discuss your findings and ask questions. For example, say "In Zone 1, the left side of your forehead, I found some congestion. You may want to pay extra attention to this zone while cleansing. Do you rinse your cleanser off well in this area?"

Once you've completed Zone 1, move onto Zone 2 and continue until you have covered all areas of the Face Mapping® skin analysis outline, repeating steps 6 and 7 for each zone. Ask questions throughout to educate your client about their skin and habits. This is critical in establishing yourself as their personal skin expert. Keep your findings in mind – you'll have a chance to note them on the Face Mapping® skin analysis outline during the pre-extraction Scaling Fluid* step of the treatment.

- Review the MicroZone® Treatment Consultation Card that your teen client has completed and ask about their current routine, habits and any possible acne medications. (1 minute)
- Perform the Dermalogica Double Cleanse that begins with **PreCleanse**.

How should I retail Clear Start[™] to my clients?

Clear Start™ is made for younger, breakout-prone clients. If your adult clients have teenage children or friends who are experiencing difficulty treating their breakouts, offer them a Breakout Clearing MicroZone® Treatment and education on treating their skin. You can also recommend Clear Start™ samples or the Breakout Clearing Kit so they can try the regimen themselves.

Do I need to prescribe all eight products?

No, but using all the products together may yield faster, more thorough results. We recommend starting with the basics (cleanser, toner and moisturizer), then adding more products to your client's regimen as you see fit.

Be sure to inform your clients that using Clear Start™ products with skin care products from other companies may not yield the best results.

How long does Clear Start[™] take to work?

Skin clearing will usually begin within the first week of using a Clear Start™ regimen, with maximum results developing within a month of consistent use.

What happens if a client's skin does not seem to be getting better after a month? Should I tell them to stop using Clear Start™?

Can adults use Clear Start™?

Clear Start[™] is designed to address teen breakouts. When treating adult breakouts, we recommend using MediBac Clearing[®] for optimum results.

What's the difference between Clear Start™ and MediBac Clearing®?

Clear Start™ is formulated for teens, while MediBac Clearing® is formulated for adults. This is because younger, breakout-prone skin has a different set of needs.

Teen skin experiences more oiliness, particularly around the T-zone, and has smaller, superficial comedones. For those who are predisposed to hereditary breakouts, sebum (oil) may also be thicker and stickier. Ingredients that help reduce bacteria, inflammation and oiliness are equally important at this stage.

Adult skin tends to experience more inflammation, leading to cysts and deeper lesions, usually around the mouth, chin and jawline. Adult breakouts tend to be more persistent, and the skin tends to be less resilient. Adults may also want to treat other skin concerns, such as signs of aging, simultaneously. For them, ingredients that help reduce inflammation are most important.
